

Although there was no Council meeting in July, the pace of activities only picked up: completed remediation of the church's electrical system to a single breaker panel, conversion of all kitchen lighting fixtures to longer-life LED, replacement of rental home refrigerator, replacement of office computer with a laptop with spam-protection software, labeling of rooms and spaces consistent with evacuation plans,



power-washing and scraping rental house and applying prime coat in readiness for paint (likely freshly applied and drying as you read this!). Refurbishing the exterior of the rental house is a major project and help is still needed; please watch for your opportunity to contribute - many hands

lighten the load! The church lounge has a new plug for the mini-fridge and is cooled by a newly donated A/C unit. Sunday School is on summer break but the children planted a productive raised-bed garden. We are working thru administrative details for insurance compliance, planning for ongoing use of spaces, mid-year auditor

review of financial accounts, expansion of Memorial Plaque and memorial donor book, and heating oil projections. Hot fudge sauce (homemade!) and strawberry topping (homemade!) on vanilla ice cream, with whipped cream and pecans, went wonderfully with fellowship time in the middle of summer as a tasty love-offering event.
